Our morning club will now be a more structured session run by Miss Brake and 'Olive Wellbeing'. The club will start at 8:00am promptly and pupils will need to be dropped off at this time. We will not be able to allow entry after this time, as we need to reduce the amount of children mixing where possible. The sessions will be £4.00 each and a letter will be going out during the first week to sign up for the half term. This will help us to monitor numbers.

On Wednesday 2nd, Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th September an 8:00am drop off is allowed and this will be free as no official session will be running, but the children will be monitored in the Year 4 classroom.

After School Club will be running as normal. Sessions are £4.50 per hour and will be billed at the end of term.
