

CURRICULUM Summer Term – Year 3

English

Writing – Non-fiction – Newspaper recount of an event
Balanced report about a character
Traditional Tales – Editing and re-writing a traditional tale from another character's perception

Reading – 'Boy at the Back of the Class' – Onjali Q. Rauf and 'Iron Man' - Ted Hughes. Reading aloud with appropriate intonation and with a clear voice, discussing unfamiliar vocabulary and perceived reasons for character decisions or actions.

SPAG – Punctuation in speech
Paragraphs for new events or a change in time and place
Word classes, particularly pronouns

Maths

Number – solve number problems. Know and use multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5, 8,10, 50 and 100

Calculations – estimate the answer to a calculation and use inverse operation to check.

Fractions – compare and order fractions. Add and subtract fractions.

Measure – compare durations of events

Time – tell and write the time from analogue into digital including the use of Roman Numerals

Shape/Geometry – draw 2D shapes and make 3D shapes. Recognise 3D shapes in different orientation and describe them

Data Handling – interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

Science

Materials: Properties – identify and compare the suitability of a material.

Living things: Plants, seeds, bulbs and growing needs – functionality of the root in particular for transportation

Computing

Office: Introduction to word – use keyboard shortcuts to edit.

E-books: Information books – culminating research project

PSHE

Anti-bullying - Taking responsibility and managing feelings

Team Players - Roles at home and school, debating and fund-raising

Humanities

Focused Study: Rainforests – Identify continents and then countries where the Rainforest is found. Explore and identify the 4 layers of the Rainforest.

Through the ages: British Monarchs and the current Monarchy

Islam: Community & Belonging – explore the meaning of belonging.
