

CURRICULUM Summer Term – Year 6

English

Writing

Mystery - Learn to plan and write a narrative, edit and make improvements to a piece of writing.

Poetry – Explore elements and features of poems, creating their own poems.

Autobiography – Use key language, structure and presentational features to write an autobiography.

Reading

“A Series of Unfortunate Events. The Bad Beginning.” by Lemony Snicket – Use inference to predict events and describe characters.

Autobiographies – A selection of sources.

SPAG

Colons, semicolons and dashes between clauses. Word classes and homonyms.

Punctuation to avoid ambiguity. Modal verbs.

Maths

Fractions – Percentages of an amount, to convert percentages to decimals and fractions. Solve problems using percentages.

Shape/Geometry – Compare and classify geometric shapes based on their properties and sizes. Illustrate and name parts of a circle. Recognise different angles. Find unknown angles. Describe position on a full coordinate grid.

Algebra – Use simple formulae. Generate and describe linear number sequences. Express missing number problems algebraically. Find pairs of numbers that satisfy an equation with two unknowns.

Science

Development of Science: Modern scientists and inventors (such as Stephen Hawking, Marie Maynard Daly)

Living Things: Plants and reproduction of plants

Computing

Coding: experiment with the basics of programming and apps

Excel: looking at spreadsheets, simple formulae and interpreting data

PSHE

People Around Us - Relationships and Identities: recognise different identities and relationships, ways of dealing with friendships

Our World: Country Comparison- investigate contrasting places in Commonwealth (link to Jubilee)

Through the ages: Periods in British History- use sources to find out about recent British History 1950s+

Islam: Community – the celebration of Eid, the birth and life of Prophet Muhammad

Islam: Belonging - Jihad as an Arabic word for the struggle against evil
