

CURRICULUM Spring Term – Year 5

English

Writing- Identify audience and purpose for writing, selecting appropriate grammar and vocabulary, using correct tenses, subject and verb agreement. Proof reading for accuracy.

Write a discussion text. (Why should people visit UK/London – link to topic)

Poetry –To write and perform a traditional ode.

Speaking and Listening

Present a spoken argument, using sequence, evidence and persuasive language.

Perform a scripted scene using theatrical effects - Shakespeare

Reading Shakespeare – Romeo and Juliet -reading aloud with accuracy and detailed discussion of text. Answering questions with reference to VIPERS – termly focus inference, explaining and vocabulary.

Calculations

finding fractions of amounts, ordering, rounding and comparing decimals, finding equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages.

Measure

convert between different units of metric measure.

Shape/Geometry

know angles, draw & measure in degrees using a protractor, know properties of triangles and quadrilaterals

Science

Environmental Science: endangered species, global warming, air pollution, carbon footprint

Materials: properties and changes of materials

Computing

Coding: Code breakers, deciphering codes, QR codes

Online Safety: cyber bullying – risks of the internet and online behaviour, Battlebots.
