

CURRICULUM Spring Term – Year 6

English

Writing

Fiction: Stories on a theme - Difference plan, draft, evaluate and edit writing, writing from a different perspective.

Non-Fiction: Reports - Survivors compose and write a recount of a real-life event (link to History unit on Titanic)

Reading 'Survivors: Extraordinary Tales from the Wild & Beyond' by David Long, Discussing vocabulary choices, tense and 3rd person perspective. 'Survivor Titanic' by Stephen Davies.

Maths

Decimals & Fractions: Percentages and fractions of amounts, multiply and divide fractions, ratios, proportion and percentages, compare and order fractions, equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting decimals (to 1 or 2 places)

Algebra: generate and continue linear sequences, generate and use simple formulae, solve equations with two unknowns

Measure: areas of a triangle, parallelogram, square and rectangle, perimeter of rectilinear shapes

Place Value: Negative numbers, brackets and order of operations

Living Things & Habitats: look at lifecycles of insects, amphibians, flowering and non-flowering plants, birds and mammals, identify the differences in life cycles, life process of reproduction in some plants & animals, classification keys, Linnean system, classification, identifying groups in a class and similarities of animals within a class

E-Books: To write an explanation and present using digital e-book technology.

Office: To extend knowledge of Excel - spreadsheets.

PSHE

Living in the Wider World: Charity, fundraising, homelessness and finances.

Living in the Wider World: Safety online, risks/worries and stereotypes.

Significant Events: Titanic building of in Ireland, passengers on board, 1st v 3rd class, sinking, survivors and aftermath
