

## CURRICULUM Summer Term – Year 1

### English

#### Writing

Information writing, retelling traditional tales using story maps. Performing and writing poems and recognising rhyming couplets. Writing postcards to our families.

#### Reading

Shared reading within class, reading comprehension with a focus on finding information to help answer questions, making plausible predictions and noticing interesting words and discuss word meanings. Read words with contractions

**SPAG Spellings-** Year 1 tricky words and then adding suffixes -s, -es, -ed, -er, -est and -ing. Adding prefix un- to words and applying simple spelling rules. Write from memory simple sentences dictated by the teacher.

#### Punctuation and Grammar

Question marks and exclamation marks, verb endings linked to spellings, linking sentences with time words, use describing words.

### Maths

#### Number

Counting forwards and backwards within 100, partitioning numbers, comparing numbers, ordering numbers and one more, one less within 100. Writing numbers in numerals and words up to 20.

#### Multiplication and Division

Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, making equal groups, adding equal groups, making arrays, making doubles, making equal groups, grouping, sharing.

#### Fractions

Finding halves and quarters of shapes and objects.

#### Shape/Geometry

Describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

### Science

#### Living things: Plants

Identifying plants, basic structure of trees, plants and flowers. Thinking about what plants need to grow.

### Computing

**Apps:** Sketching flowers and plants, typing skills.

**Internet Use:** Web Skills. Use Google to find information to support work and internet safety.

### PSHE

**Relationships** – Friendships and qualities of a good friend. Families - Who is in their family. Recognising families are different.

### Humanities

**UK and map work:** Local maps and places we've visited. Learn about the different types of weather.

#### Through the Ages:

Holidays to the seaside – comparing now and then.

### RE

**Christianity** – Creation story and other Bible stories

**Judaism:** Shabbat – importance to Jewish people, ways of celebrating.

### Art

**Artist Study** – Look at the work of Vincent Van Gogh. Learn about his life and work. Recreate our own paintings of sunflowers using poster and water colour paints.
