

CURRICULUM Summer Term – Year 4

English

Writing - Fiction Writing – To write a letter based on our class reader as a character from the book considering varied perspectives.

Reading - Whole Class Reader - 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane' by Kate DiCamillo. Use VIPERS to answer comprehension questions with increasing accuracy.

SPAG - Possessive pronouns. Homophones. Conjunctions indicating time and cause. Writing and punctuating speech. Verb inflections and Word classes.

Maths

Number - Understand there are numbers 'below' zero called negative numbers. Count backwards through zero to include negative numbers, column add/subtract with 3- & 4-digit numbers. Add & subtract 0.1s & 0.01s.

Decimals – Recognise, write and compare decimals. Round decimals with one decimal place to the nearest whole.

Measure - Measure in m, cm, mm; convert units, measures problems.

Shape/Geometry - Line of symmetry: identify and construct. Know and be able to read the eight main points on a compass. Find the area/perimeter of rectilinear shapes.

Science

Electricity – Exploring what is electricity, conductors and insulators and investigating into circuits.

Sound – Understanding vibrations and connecting how we hear.

Digital age: iMovies – script and create their own short film

Online Safety: Sharing information and safety

PSHE

Health and Wellbeing: Positive and negative effects of sleep, routines, oral hygiene. Expressing feelings. Mental health and mixed media messages.

Humanities

Through the ages: Castles – Features, famous castles, comparative study.

UK and Map Work: Mountains & Rivers - Grid references and keys.

RE

Judaism: Beliefs and practices - Relationships with God.

Christianity: Prayer & Worship - Baptism, Eucharist/Holy Communion.

Art

Artist study & modern artists: Monet - To explore Impressionism.
